II. Life is Precious

- A. Psalm 139:14-17
- B. Wonderfully = Set Apart
 - 1. Man is not like the beasts – man has a soul
 - a) Jesus did not die for the animals, but He did die for you
 - b) “**Your** Life is Precious”
 - (1) I’m glad he loved and died for the sins of the world, but I’m glad he loved ‘me’
 - (2) Galatians 2:20 ... loved me...died for me
 - (3) Old cartoon drawing - I know I’m somebody, cause God don’t make no junk!
 - 2. Hebrews 2:5-9
 - a) Dominion Reviewed
 - (1) Destiny of Man (5)
 - (a) Genesis 1:26-28 – God made man to have dominion of all things
 - (2) Dignity of Man (6)
 - (3) Distinction of Man (7-8a)
 - (a) Why does man strive to conquer things (space, animals, oceans), because he knows he is supposed to have dominion
 - b) Dominion Revoked (8b)
 - c) Dominion Revived (9)
 - (1) Jesus had dominion over the animals and elements
 - (a) One day we will be like Jesus - I John 3:2; Ephesians 4:13
